V. Requirements for Graduation

- A. 180 quarter units are required for the Bachelor of Arts degree.
- B. UCI General Education and University requirements must be fulfilled.
- C. UCI's Residence Requirement (36 of the last 45 units must be taken at UCI) is met.
- D. All courses taken to fulfill school and major requirements must be taken for a letter grade (except SOCECOL 195).
- E. Certification for the B.A. degree requires overall, School & upper-division major requirements be at a 2.0 GPA.

Note that students must apply for graduation by the deadline per communications from the Office of Student Services in the School of Social Ecology as graduation is not automatic. Students must apply via StudentAccess for the quarter in which they plan to graduate. Students with questions concerning graduation should meet with an academic counselor or peer advisor.
