School of Social Ecology Take Your Professor to Lunch

How It Works

Invite one other undergraduate student (must be a major in our School) to join you for lunch with a Social Ecology professor. After you have reached out to your professor and selected a date, please e-mail Social Ecology Student Services at sepeer@uci.edu at least 3 business days prior to your scheduled lunch to check-out a meal card. In your e-mail, please include the name of your guest, faculty member, and date.

Your meal card will be accepted at all on-campus dining locations, except the University Club, Anthill Pub & Grille, Café Expresso, and Express Yourself. Each person is allowed to spend up to \$12. **Meal cards along with an itemized receipt must be returned to Maria Spangenberg in Student Services, immediately following lunch.** No exceptions will be made. You will also be asked to complete a brief evaluation form to reflect on and evaluate your experience. We also encourage a group photo to be taken and e-mailed to mspangen@uci.edu within 24 hours.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I participate in the program more than once per quarter?

No, you can only participate once per quarter. This gives more students access to this unique opportunity.

Can I invite a faculty member from a different academic unit to lunch?

No, this program is only open to Social Ecology professors and students.

Can I invite my TA (or graduate student) instead of a professor?

No. While we recognize the importance of getting to know graduate students, we would like you to connect with a faculty member in the School of Social Ecology.

Can I invite someone else to join me and my professor for lunch?

Yes. You are required to have one other student join you for lunch with your professor.

I lost my meal card. Can I get a replacement card?

Lost or stolen meal cards must be reported to Maria Spangenberg immediately. You may be responsible for paying a \$15 fee to replace the card.

When do I return the meal card?

Your meal card must be returned to Maria Spangenberg in 102 Social Ecology I (Office of Student Services) immediately following lunch. No exceptions will be granted.
