

2013-2014 FUDGE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The Fudge Family Foundation has established a limited-time scholarship opportunity for Social Ecology students who have a strong academic record and who have established financial need because they are self-supporting or have other personal hardships that would make it difficult for them to complete their studies without this assistance. Fudge Family Scholars will have demonstrated a strong work ethic and self-motivation. Ideally, two students will receive an award of up to \$5,000 for the 2013-2014 academic year.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Full-time enrollment.
- Current UC Irvine junior or senior-level student.
- A major within the School of Social Ecology (at the time of application and must remain an SE major throughout duration of the award).
- **Minimum** 3.3 cumulative GPA.
- Two 500 word essays that address scholastic achievement, work ethic, and self-motivation.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Financial need as determined by the UCI Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships.

Each letter should call attention to your academic accomplishments, your financial need and situation, and how the scholarship would help you complete your studies. The letters should be written by individuals who are well-positioned to attest to your financial need, your work ethic academically and as an employee or worker, and to your motivation to complete your education. Each letter should be in a sealed envelope and submitted with this application. {Optional: You may submit more than two letters. }
