Job Descriptions

Administrative Internship:

- Opportunity to work closely with Student Services staff

- Work at least 10 hours a week and earn 4 units of 198 credits each quarter

Field Study Internship:

- Areas of responsibility may include one or more of the following depending on program needs and student interests: event coordination, program evaluation, marketing and public relations, authoring newsletter articles, developing or enhancing program materials, and developing and/or presenting workshops and presentations, creating reports, and data analysis.
- Planning and coordinating quarterly Field Study Meet and Greets
- Opportunity to shadow the field study director on site visits and other campus and community meetings.
- Create a project that will help improve and be beneficial to the Field Study Program
- Past projects have included developing and implementing field study focus groups, conceiving and implementing field study community partner spotlights, and creating a new class that helps prepare students for Field Study.
- Work 10 hours a week and earn 4 units of 198 credits each quarter.
