

Sample Urban Studies B.A. 2-year plan for transfer students

This plan assumes the following

- 105 quarter units (70 semester units) were transferred to UCI with a full UC IGETC.
- American History and Institutions requirements were met upon admission to UCI.

***Please note that this same plan is simply a suggestion for how to plan your courses. Your schedule will vary based on course availability and your curricular needs. AP or IB credit earned in high school or completed community college coursework may affect the plan above.*

Keep in mind

- Most school requirements (Crm/Law C7, PSCI 11ABC, SocEcol 1, SocEcol 13, UPPP 4) are offered every quarter.
- SocEcol 195, Field Study, requires advanced planning. Make sure you understand the process at least 2 quarters PRIOR to the quarter you plan on taking SocEcol 195.
 - SocEcol 10 is a prerequisite for SocEcol 195.
- Elective courses may be used to fulfill unit requirements to graduate and may be used to fulfill requirements for a second major, minor, research, study abroad, or UCDC/UC Sacramento.
- Per academic senate guidelines 1 unit = 3 hours of student workload per week. For a 4 unit course, you should expect to spend 12 hours per week engaged in the class to do well. This includes lectures, discussions, projects, papers, review sessions, office hours, etc.

 - School, major, and UC GPA must be at least 2.0 to be eligible for graduation

Total = 185 units. All B.A. requirements completed.

Note: a minimum of 180 quarter units is required in order to graduate.
