A. SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS (8 courses/32 units)

1. CRM/LAW C7 Introduction to Criminology, Law and Society
2. ENVIRON E8 Introduction to Environmental Analysis and Design
3. PSY BEH 9 Introduction to Psychology (*same as Psych 7A*) **OR**
PSY BEH 11ABC Psychology Fundamentals (*must complete entire series*)
4. SOCECOL 10 Research Design
5. SOCECOL 13 Statistical Analysis in Social Ecology
6. SOCECOL 194W Naturalistic Field Research
7. SOCECOL 195 Field Study (four units) *P/NP only grade option. Prerequisites are SE10 and SE194W.*
8. An additional four units of Field Study (195) **or** a four unit upper-division course in any department in the School of Social Ecology (choose from the following departments: CRM/LAW, ENVIRON, PP&D, PSY BEH, SOCECOL.) *Note: Directed Studies (SE198) and Special Studies (SE199) may not be used to fulfill this requirement.*

B. GENERAL SOCIAL ECOLOGY MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

Ten (10) upper division courses, 40 units, in the School of Social Ecology chosen from any of the following departments and course numbers. Courses MUST be taken for a grade, P/NP courses will not count toward major requirements.

Planning, Policy & Design
Psychology & Social Behavior
Social Ecology

CRM/LAW C100 – C193
ENVIRON E100 – E193
PP&D 100 – 193
PSYBEH 100 – 193
SOCECOL 100 – 193

Students are responsible for any pre-requisites imposed on courses by the individual departments.

Students may, by petition, count 1 Social Ecology 199 course and Social Ecology graduate courses (numbered 200-290) toward upper division requirements.

Use of a 199 or a graduate course as an upper division course is not automatic. Petitions for 199 and General Petitions for graduate courses are available at:

Public Health courses **DO NOT** fulfill degree requirements for a B.A. in Social Ecology, unless they are cross-listed with one of the departments and course numbers above. Public Health Courses are offered by the College of Health Sciences, not the School of Social Ecology.

C. ADDITIONAL UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION ARE:

- 180 quarter units are required for the Bachelor of Arts degree
- UCI General Education Requirements or Breadth Requirements
- Entry Level Writing Requirement (Subject A), American History and American Institutions requirements must be completed

All courses taken to fulfill School and Major requirements **must be taken for a letter grade** with the exception of SE195. Certification for the B.A. degree Social Ecology is dependent upon a 2.0 Grade Point Average in the overall, school and upper division major requirements.

NOTE: Student must apply for graduation by the deadline specified on the SE Student Services website. Graduation is not automatic – students must apply for the quarter in which they plan to graduate.
